According to the program b, one topic is planned for one week, and in all classes, it is explained to the children through various methods and methods, and this topic is broken into their minds. As a result, children will have deep knowledge, skills and abilities on this subject and will be able to apply the knowledge they have acquired in practice. Classes are conducted in a general way and are continued in development centers. By using new pedagogical technologies and various didactic games during classes, it is possible to achieve full implementation of the competencies specified in the program. In particular, the use of interactive methods in training increases the effectiveness of education. Interactive methods encourage students to think independently, teach them to work together in a team. Interactive methods include solving problem situations, blitz- search, role -playing games, brainstorming, and BBB. Through the "Simple and complex questions" method, which is one of the interactive methods, children are asked questions in two ways: simple and complex. Such questions can be used at different stages of training.
