### **DISCUSSIONS**

When teaching the laws, concepts and principles of the subject "Fundamentals of Civil Society," special attention should be paid to:

- wide use of interactive teaching methods in the formation of students' creative thinking in educational institutions;

### **Conclusion**

In conclusion, the decree provides for the creation of the "Youth - Our Future" fund under the Youth Union of Uzbekistan and the provision of preferential loans and property on lease through commercial banks for the implementation of youth business initiatives, startups, projects and projects at a rate of 7 percent per annum. The decree states that households in which unoccupied youth live will be assisted in the acquisition of up to 20 birds and rabbits, 5 small and 2 large cattle with the return of their value on time and their subsequent sale. This, along with employment, contributes to the formation of entrepreneurial skills among young people.

Many "problems and delinquencies" result from the amount of time available. In this regard, the creation of coworking centers "Young Entrepreneurs" and complexes "Youth Labor Guzar"[6].

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
