

**FORMATION OF A CULTURE OF COMMUNICATION IN THE EDUCATOR'S  
WORK ACTIVITY**

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**Abstract:** First of all, pedagogues are responsible persons for the development of our society. His speech, manners, and education are of special importance. Therefore, first of all, a pedagogue should acquire the culture of speaking.

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A conversationalist should always study the culture of other "dialogue" and in turn, incessantly search for himself. In dealing with students, a pedagogue needs special pedagogical skills. For example, how well he knows the student, taking into account his psychology and social background, etc. It is very important to involve the students in the lesson, to achieve any effect, the pedagogue, in turn, should know how to speak and use his pedagogical skills in conversation, lecture, story, and other subjects. In general, it is necessary to be able to communicate with students during educational processes. In order for a teacher to communicate with students, he must have enough pedagogical skills. For this, the pedagogue must follow the six rules of pedagogy.

These are: What to teach a child, who to teach, how to teach!!! What to teach?

1. To help the student to know and understand the news in science;
2. To fully master each academic subject;
3. To form skills, qualifications and abilities;
4. To implement the connection between academic subjects;
5. It consists in teaching to fully master the educational content.

How to teach?

The pedagogue influences children using various pedagogical methods and methods in the educational process.

The teacher can use the following methods of influencing students:

- demand;
- see prospects;
- encouragement;
- punish;
- referring to public judgment.

Who to teach?

1. Based on the psychological characteristics of the students, to determine the level of their knowledge and how they were brought up;

2. Early identification of the student's difficulties in moving from one level to another;
3. Taking into account the organization of educational processes;
4. The pedagogue should organize his work taking into account various mental changes in students;
5. It is necessary to identify talented students and organize work with them individually. The teacher's demand is the initial method of pedagogical influence, and the student feels responsibility and demand for himself. Promotion is to reward a student for useful and exemplary work for other students. Punishment - ensuring that students are stopped from inappropriate work and behavior in order to correct their behavior. The opinion of the public is to reward students in every way for the social and useful activities they have done in the school.

Means of influence of the teacher on the students by mutual exchange of ideas:

- persuasion;
- influence;
- show influence by mutual exchange of ideas. Influence on the child with persuasion is used in the teaching process in the form of creative conversations, open discussions, and setting an example. A teacher should have the following skills when communicating with students.
- Possessing the ability to control a group of students during educational processes;
- Pedagogical attitude should be acquired by culture;
- Having organizational skills;
- Should have mastered the methods of managing educational processes..

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
